

# UNIFORM DRESS CODE - *ELEMENTARY*

Students at CCS are required to wear uniforms. Girls' plaid skirts, skorts, and jumpers must be purchased from Dennis Uniforms in Yorba Linda. Other articles of clothing may be purchased at Dennis or Mervyn's stores.

Directions to Store:

Take the 91 Freeway to the Yorba Linda Blvd. /Weir Canyon Exit. Take Yorba Linda Blvd. North (toward the city of Yorba Linda). Go under the freeway and pass Taco Bell. Immediately take Savi Ranch Parkway to the right. Pass Mirage Street. Costco is on your left. Continue approximately two blocks and turn into the driveway on your left at Savi Ranch Café.

It is the responsibility of the student and parent(s) to assure that the child is in proper attire while at school.

## **Girls**

Jumpers, shifts, and skirts may be no shorter than 2" above the top of the knee cap.

Skorts and shorts may be no shorter than 3" above the top of the knee cap.

Girls in grades K-3 must wear shorts (i.e. athletic/bike shorts etc.) under all skirts, jumpers. It is recommended that girls in grades 4-5 wear shorts under all skirts and jumpers.

### **Chapel Dress**

On chapel day (Wednesdays), girls must wear a uniform skirt, jumper, or skort with any school approved uniform shirt/blouse.

On **VERY RAINY, WINDY, OR COLD DAYS**, girls may wear uniform slacks to school for chapel day. A very rainy, cold day is one on which the high temperature for the day (for Santa Ana) would be 60 degrees or less.

**A MISTY MORNING** is not considered a rainy day!

### **Accessories**

Girls may wear earrings in ears only. Earrings should be conservative in size and style. Earrings that are large, dangling or swing freely must be removed for P.E. No more than two earrings may be worn in each ear at any time, including ear clips. Other complimentary jewelry may be worn, but not in excess. Girls may not wear hats except on approved occasions. Girls in grades K – 6 may wear clear nail polish only! **NO MAKEUP!**

### **Field Trip Polo Shirts:**

Students in grades K-6 will be required to purchase at least one short sleeved red polo shirt with the Calvary logo embroidered on it, to be used for classroom field trips. These polos are available at Dennis Uniform only!

## **Boys**

Shorts may be no shorter than 3" above the top of the knee cap and no longer than 4" below the knee cap.

### **Chapel Dress**

On chapel day (Wednesdays), boys must wear uniform slacks and collared uniform shirts. (*Exception – K-4th grade boys who have P.E. on Wednesday may wear shorts*). Turtlenecks may also be worn (but not as an undershirt). On a **VERY HOT DAY** (90 degrees or above in Santa Ana), boys may wear uniform shorts on chapel day.

### **Hair**

Hair must be trimmed above the eyebrows and kept off the neck (no longer than the top of a collared shirt). Hair must be neat (no shaggy unkempt look). Hair may cover up to one half of the ear. No extreme fad hairstyles, including shaved lines or tails will be accepted.

### **HAIR COLOR**

Hair must be student's natural color (no lighteners, lemon juice, etc.).

### **Accessories**

Boys may not wear earrings at any time. Boys may not wear hats except on approved occasions. Chains hanging from pants and/or shorts may not be worn. Necklaces are acceptable.

## **Boys and Girls**

Pants and shorts are to be worn at the waist and must be appropriate size. "Baggy" and/or "off the hips" fit will not be accepted.

A coordinating belt must be worn with ALL pants, shorts, and jeans.

ALL shirts and blouses must be tucked in while students are on campus.

### **FOOTWEAR**

**ALL footwear** must be flat soled (for safety reasons on staircases) and have enclosed heels or heel straps. **White** socks or peds must be worn at all times. (*Exception: sandals may be worn without socks.*) Girls may wear solid colored tights, knee highs or nylons which coordinate with the school uniform. **NO SKATE SHOES!!**

## **LUNCHPAILS / BACKPACKS / SLEEPING BAGS / ETC.**

When purchasing these items for school, please adhere to the basic guidelines for appropriate subject matter. For example, Batman, X-Men, Little Mermaid, Power Rangers, Pokemon, Bart Simpson, Beavis & Butthead, Tasmanian Devil, Pinky and the Brain, etc., are not appropriate. When in doubt, please contact the school office for clarification.

## **OUTERWEAR**

There are no restrictions on heavy winter coats (i.e. ski, down, wool, etc.).

### ***Additional Outerwear***

All other outerwear (i.e. sweaters, sweatshirts, vests, windbreakers, lightweight jackets, pull-over hooded / unhooded fleece jackets) must be **plain and solid Navy Blue Only with no logos other than the CCS logo!**

## **FRIDAY "BLUE JEANS" DAY**

Every Friday will be "blue jeans" day.

Students will be permitted to wear this denim in pants, shorts, skorts, skirts, jumpers, or overalls. Students not participating in "jeans day" will be required to wear their regular school uniform. Shirts must be any school approved uniform shirt and must be tucked in while the student is on campus. Belts must be worn and no hats will be permitted. No baggy, torn, ragged hem, or worn out/faded denim is acceptable.

## **FREE DRESS DAYS**

Occasionally CCS will announce "Free Dress" days. The following guidelines are to be adhered to:

Acceptable dress includes:

Hats (to be removed inside buildings), sweats, un-tucked shirts, regular shorts (no more than 4" above the knee), shoes without socks. Dresses, skirts, jumpers, etc., must be uniform dress code length (2" from top of knee cap).

Unacceptable dress includes:

Any clothing that is too tight or see-through, worn, torn or ragged looking, tights or leggings worn as pants, bike shorts, and "baggy" style pants, dresses with spaghetti straps, shirts with derogatory slogans, tank tops, or any shirt which exposes the tummy, are not accepted.

Sandals **without** heel straps may not be worn at any time.

## **FREE CHAPEL DRESS/PICTURE DAY FREE DRESS**

Guidelines for Free Chapel / Picture Day Dress include:

For Boys:

Dress slacks and any collared shirt are acceptable. Shirts must be tucked in and belts worn. No hats will be permitted.

For Girls:

Dresses, jumpers, and skirts are acceptable and must be uniform dress code length. Hats, spaghetti strap dresses, and jeans are not permitted.

## **Dress Code Violation Information**

The uniform dress code applies to all school functions and activities unless otherwise instructed. Please understand your obligation to cooperate. Dress guidelines remain the same from September through June. When purchasing skirts, jumpers, skorts or shorts, allowance for growth should be considered. Final decisions on Dress Code will be made by the administration. "Out of Uniform" specific procedures will be followed. Please check with your individual classroom for discipline policies.
