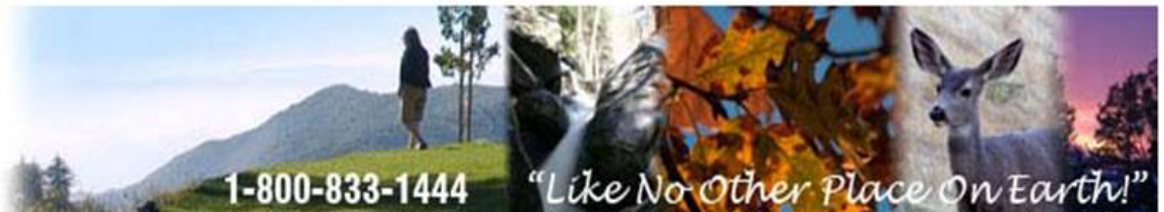
MAN CAMP SPEAKER AND THEME:

Dr. Barry Corey became the eighth president of Biola University on July 1, 2007 officially launching the celebration of the University's centennial year. Dr. Corey, 46, succeeded Clyde Cook, who retired in June, 2007. Barry Corey is a Massachusetts native and roots for the Red Sox, but we will try not to hold that against him. He has an extensive academic background, but understands the business world through his fundraising and development experience. He is a highly gifted and relatable communicator of God's Word. ARRIVING HOME

Man Camp will conclude at approximately 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, June 1st. Lunch will NOT be served on Sunday so you can either enjoy a meal on the road or just wait until you get home.

ACTIVITIES OFFERED

- Horseback Riding- Trail ride, \$20/person
- Paintball - Up to 20 players per game. Palomar provides the referee, masks, markers and paint; you provide the survival instinct. \$20/person
- Archery - Bows ranging from 15lbs to 35lbs available. Sorry, no compound bows allowed. Price: FREE
- Rifle Range - Shoot 22 caliber rifles at spinning targets and 20 gauge shotguns at skeet launched from our rifle range. Price: BB guns, FREE; rifles: 10 shots/\$1; skeet, 3 shots/\$1. You may bring your own guns, but there can be no handguns, semi-auto, or fully auto weapons. Shotguns can't be more than 12-gage. Your guns must remain locked in your vehicle when not on the range.
- Swimming Pool - Experience our waterslide, or just tan by our
- Baseball, Volleyball, Basketball, Soccer, Football - stop by to shoot some hoops or toss a Frisbee. Sports equipment provided.
- Horse Shoes & Ping Pong - Arrange for a competition at one of our two horse shoe pits or at any of our four ping pong tables.
- Palomar Mountain State Park - Located adjacent to our property, Palomar Mountain State Park offers a myriad of hiking and mountain biking trails that interconnect with our own for virtually unlimited hiking possibilities. The State Park offers spectacular vistas and opportunities for outdoor exploration.
