When you may feel undervalued, God's grace loves to surprise us. Learn how He values your life as you travel with Him.
- 2.07.10 Genesis 17 { Covenant of Circumcision }**  
Ever feel as though God has forgotten about you? Do you tend to forget about Him? God's loves to establish covenants to constantly reassure of His blessing in our lives.
