- Are you the one who should build me a house?
– vs. 5

1 Chronicles 22:7-8

David said to Solomon, "My son, I had intended to build a house to the name of the LORD my God. "But the word of the LORD came to me, saying, 'You have shed much blood and have waged great wars; you shall not build a house to My name, because you have shed so much blood on the earth before Me.

III. God's Answer

- Are you the one who should build me a house?

– vs. 5

1. Man who has shed blood. **1 Chronicles**

22:7-8

2. Who are you to think I need a house? – vs.

7

3. What do we do that makes God feel like we are saying He isn't in charge?

III. God's Answer

- Are you the one who should build me a house?
- 2 Samuel 7:8-17
- **You will not build me a house. I will build you a house. – vs. 11b, 16**
 1. This is the covenant that God makes with David.
 2. God's answers of NO can many times mean there is a bigger YES.

IV. David's Response

- Please Remain Seated. Termine Ser Sentado Por Favor. David's response was to sit.
- Then we praise God for how great He is – vs. 22-24
- David not only yields to God, but he boldly implores God to truly be God and faithfully keep His promises – vs. 25-29

V. Our Response

- Our response should be the same as David's.
To sit before Him literally and symbolically.

V. Our Response

- **RESPONSE DURING THE SERVICE** – During this time of singing, spend some time meditating on your life and your need to "sit" before the Lord as David did. This could be talking to God about beginning a relationship with Him and accepting His promises of salvation and forgiveness. It could also be recognizing areas of your life where you need to give up control to the Lord. Or you could just sit in silence in the presence of a Holy God.
