In the last ten years, approximately one-third of our giving went to ministry needs outside our church. In the Restoration Project, over one-third is designated to Reach ministry outside our church.

From our beginning, local outreach began in 1932 in Orange County's jails and hospitals. Calvary also began a partnership with the Los Angeles Rescue Mission and San Pedro Mission Ministries. In 1943, the Christian Servicemen's Organization began ministering to servicemen who stayed on our campus.

Now we want to continue that faithful legacy of reaching out as we look to God for greater things still to come.
